

WORKING GRASSLAND PARTNERSHIP III

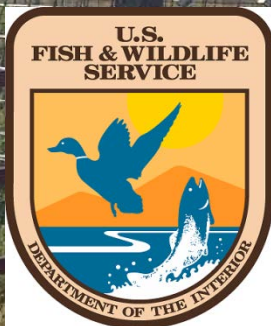
The North Dakota Natural Resources Trust, North Dakota Association of Soil Conservation Districts, Ducks Unlimited, Pheasants Forever, and the North Dakota Outdoor Heritage Fund have partnered to offer landowners the Working Grassland Partnership III program.

How WGP III Works

The Working Grassland Partnership Phase 3 (WGP III) grant proposal will promote livestock grazing as a management tool for improving grassland bird conservation. WGP III will provide landowners with voluntary options to help develop expiring CRP acres into a livestock grazing systems that will also benefit grassland birds.

Outdoor Heritage Fund

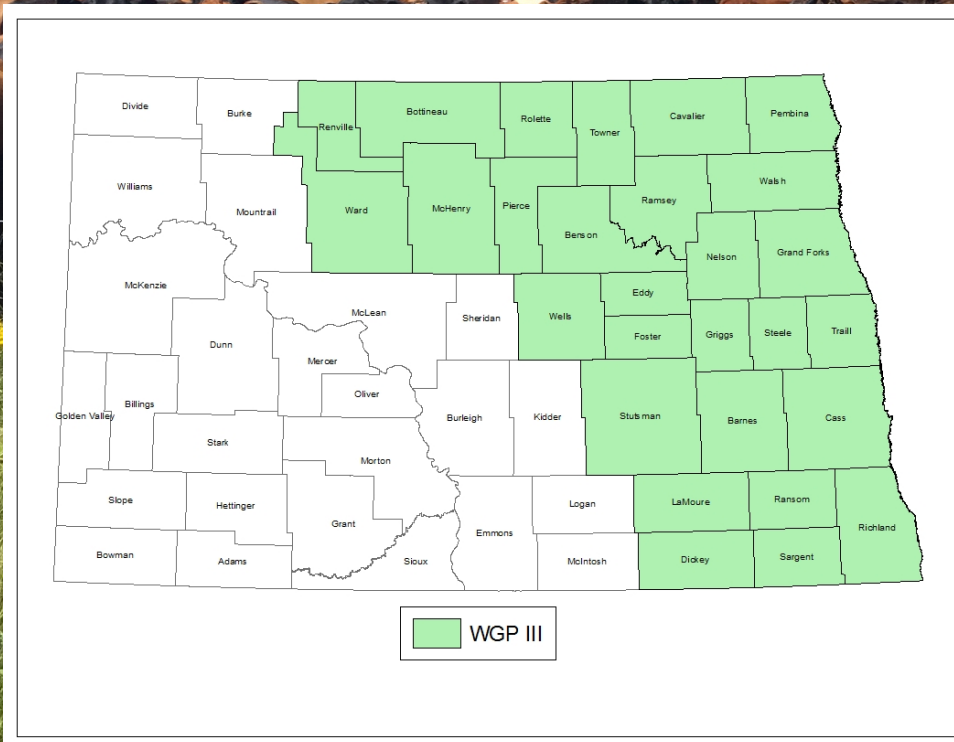
OHF is a state grant program which provides grant funds for projects that include access to public and private lands for sportsmen, implementation of best management practices for farming and ranching stewardship of the land and water, fish and wildlife habitat preservation, and development of parks and outdoor recreation areas.



Working Grassland Partnership III Program Offers:

- 10 Year Agreements with buyback provisions
- Lease payment for 2017, 2018, and 2019 expiring CRP contract acres.
One-time payment of \$50 per acre
- 60% Cost-Share on Boundary and Cross Fencing
- 60% Cost-Share on Water Development
Wells, rural water hook-ups, pipeline, tanks, etc.
- NDGFD PLOTS access options
